Utah Parents United has serious concerns about SB121. Please hold this bill in committee.

As parents we support education that encourages entrepreneurship, skill development, job readiness, and college prep.

However, we believe each School District should determine based on location, resources and student population what programs to engage in.

Generally, we are opposed to the state government funding pilot programs that push one-size-fits-all curriculum and programs on school districts.

We believe the role of the legislature is to enforce the law through legislation that supports teacher and administrator responsibility, accountability.

With a \$30 million price tag this bill will funnel money to municipalities and nonprofits to get involved in our children's education.

We don't need MORE government in our schools.

Parental engagement is the key to high graduation rates, high academic achievement, and lower rates of depression and anxiety.

We are opposed to SB121.
